Incidental Billing: There are areas of our program that require incidental billing. These charges may include, but are not limited to: purchases of snacks from the canteen, uniforms, extra elective classes, field trips, etc. Typically, you will be notified for prior consent before the purchase and subsequent billing occurs.

Late Fees: All accounts are due and payable by the 1st of each month (starting August 1) and are past due after the 10th. A \$15.00 late fee will be assessed for accounts not paid by the 10th. Failure to pay as agreed will lead to the interruption of enrollment for your child(ren) at CEC.

Withdrawal: CEC requires a one-month written notice before disenrollment. This month will need to be paid in full whether the child is in attendance or not. We do not pro-rate fees. To ease the financial burden on parents, CEC chooses to bill curriculum fees on a bi-annual payment plan. CEC incurs these full costs at the beginning of the year. Therefore, January 1 curriculum fees must be paid regardless of disenrollment date.

Final report cards, student transcripts, and official records will not be released until accounts are paid in full.

Scholarships

<u>NC Opportunity Scholarship</u>- This is a state-funded program offered through the NCSEAA. Applications for these grants open in February prior to the school year. Parent is responsible for any balance not covered. Visit <u>http://www.ncseaa.edu/OSG.htm</u> for more information and to apply.

<u>Calvary UPC Scholarship-</u> A scholarship for partial tuition assistance is made available to families who apply and meet the qualification guidelines. Prior to applying for the Calvary UPC Scholarship, it is <u>required</u> for families to, first, apply for the NC Opportunity Scholarship. New families must be accepted for enrollment prior to applying. Applications are available at the school office.
